

DON'T TRY TO SHOW TEN POUNDS OF LENTICULAR IN A FIVE POUND BUCKET

keep animations simple

Each lenticular lens can only handle so much animation before it starts to get blurry and confusing to the viewer.

- A two or three phase flip is often as effective as animation.
- Simple animations look cleaner and ghost less.
- Choose the appropriate lens for the job.

DO 25 JUMPING JACK IN PLACE TO GET YOUR LENTICULAR MOVING

animate on top of itself

The last thing you want is for your client to be confused when they view lenticular.

- Keep key animated elements anchored in one place.
- Loop animation for a consistent and smooth effect.
- Use the highest resolution source footage possible.

WHITE IS A BAD IDEA AFTER LABOR DAY AND EVERYDAY WHEN IT COMES TO LENTICULAR

minimize the white

We're not saying you can't use white...just be careful when you do.

- White or light backgrounds on flips or animations create ghosting.
- Animating white objects can cause color registration problems.
- Keep white objects close to the focal plane in 3D compositions for clarity.

lots of layers

If you ever think you have too many layers...you don't.

- Layers are used to create depth in 3D lenticular (the more the better).
- Set up flips and animations as layers in one file.
- Layered files allow us to work quickly.



I ALWAYS WANTED A LITTLE RED WAGON, NOT A LITTLE MONOTONE ONE

bright, bold colors

White is not an ideal choice for lenticular, but color, now that's a different story.

- Bright bold colors create deep 3D and engaging effects.
- Bold colors show up better on flips than subtle shifts in color.
- Avoid using colors flipping over light colors to minimize ghosting.

IF YOU HAVE TO DRAW A LINE IN THE SAND, MAKE IT THICK

thick lines & bold text

Whomever said "thin is in" doesn't work with lenticular.

- Thin lines or strokes break up or disappear under lens.
- Bold sans-serif fonts read better under lens than Roman-style fonts.
- Barcodes and QR codes can read under lens with correct setup.

LENTICULAR LOOKS BETTER WITH A 5 O'CLOCK SHADOW JUST LIKE MIAMI VICE

use texture

Want great 3D? Want to eliminate ghosting? Then add texture!

- Full compositions look and work great in 3D.
- Use texture or other background elements to hide ghosting.
- Add texture or elements in the background to create great depth.
